MAJOR FUNCTIONS AND DUTIES OF THE DRUGS CONTROLLER (AYURVEDA) WING IS:

- Enforcement of the provisions of the Drugs and Cosmetic Act 1940.
- Assure the availability of good quality drugs and preventing the use of substandard drugs by regular collection of drugs samples available in the market and from the manufacturing units, for quality checking.
- Ensuring that, all the drug manufacturing units under the state are functioning in compliance with requirements imposed in Schedule T.
- Issuing of drug license, product approval, GMP Certificate and other required certificates for the manufacturing and sale of ayurveda siddha unani drugs as per the mandate of Drugs and Cosmetics Act.
- Enforcement of Drugs and Magic Remedies (Objectionable Advertisement) Act 1954.
- Initiation of legal actions including prosecution against offenders as per the provision of Drugs and cosmetics Act and Rules and Drugs and Magic Remedies (Objectionable Advertisement) Act 1954.
- Conduction of periodic capacity building programs for enforcement officers, ministerial staffs and also for the analytical officers under the drug testing laboratories working for the drugs control ayurveda wing.
- Documentation of licenses issued and other records associated with the functioning of the department.
- To combat any other issues relating to the Ayurveda Sidha and Unani drugs.
