JUDGMENT

The petitioner presented Ext P2 agreement for sale and consequential sale deed for registration. By Ext P3 the Sub Registrar suggested that the petitioner to apply for probate the unregistered Will on the strength of the aforesaid documents were presented and to re-present the same. As seen from Ext P2 itself it was only a suggestion to avoid further dispute in the matter. Since the Will is not a compulsorily registerable document certainly it is an option for the petitioner to probate such Will or not. It means that for the purpose of registration it cannot be insisted that unregistered 'Will' be probated. Therefore, this court is of the view that without probating the Will the documents presented by the petitioner shall be accepted for registration in accordance with law.

Writ Petition is disposed of as above.
